



MINI VINTAGE LANTERN – ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for selecting RH Baby & Child lighting. Our assortment is crafted with the highest quality materials that coordinate perfectly with our Baby & Child bedding collections, making it easy to create an elegant nursery or child's bedroom. Each item's surface is sealed, which eliminates the need for polishing and ensures a lasting finish for years to come.

PARTS ENCLOSED:

- (A) LED bulb
- (B) Door
- (C) Socket
- (D) Plug

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

For safety purposes, this lamp is equipped with a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). If the plug does not fit securely into your outlet, do not force it - contact a professional electrician. Use the plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket. Never alter the plug in any way.

This lamp has been rated for up to (1) 1w max Type T LED bulb (included) or (1) 40w max Type T incandescent bulb (not included). To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

WARNINGS:

All wires are connected. When unpacking, be careful not to pull wires, as a bad connection may result. Do not connect electricity until your lamp is fully assembled.

To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off and unplug lamp and allow it to cool prior to replacing lightbulb.

Do not touch bulb when lamp is turned on or look directly at lit bulb.

Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic covering.
2. Place the lamp base on the tabletop carefully.
3. Open the door (B) and insert the (1) LED bulb (A) into the threaded socket (C).
4. Plug into proper electrical outlet and test the lamp.
5. Assembly is complete.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Do not use polishes or cleaners on your lamp.
WIPE CLEAN WITH A SOFT, DRY CLOTH.
