

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Tighten the metal bracket on to the wall and furniture piece with the help of the screw given. For dry wall fixing, mini anchors are to be used along with the screws.
- 2. Tighten the steel cable (3) on to the brackets (4) on the wall and on the product as shown below.
- 3. Tighten the cord grip as required and adjust the spacing with the wall accordingly.
