

## ACADEMY TASK FLOOR LAMP - ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

### PARTS ENCLOSED:

- (A) LED bulb
- (B) Lamp arm
- (C) Small metal column
- (D) Medium metal column
- (E) Large metal column
- (F) Adjustable handlebar
- (G) Bottom tube
- (H) Lamp base

### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

For safety purposes, this lamp is equipped with a polarized plug (one prong is wider than the other). If the plug does not fit securely into your outlet, do not force it - contact a professional electrician. Use the plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket. Never alter the plug in any way.

This lamp has been rated for up to (1) 60-Watt maximum Type A standard incandescent lightbulb (not included), one (1) 23-Watt maximum compact fluorescent lightbulb (not included), OR one (1) 12-Watt maximum LED lightbulb (not included). (1) 9W LED lightbulb is included with this lamp. To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

### WARNINGS:

All wires are connected. When unpacking, be careful not to pull wires, as a bad connection may result. Do not connect electricity until your lamp is fully assembled.

To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off and unplug lamp and allow it to cool prior to replacing lightbulb.

Do not touch bulb when lamp is turned on or look directly at lit bulb.  
Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.

### **⚠ WARNING: STRANGULATION HAZARD**

Keep cord at least 3 feet away from cribs, bassinets, and toddler beds. Keep out of each of children under 3 years of age.

### TO ASSEMBLE:

1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic coverings.
2. Pull the wire from the lamp base (H). Place the bottom tube (G) onto the lamp base (H) and turn the bottom tube (G) clockwise to tighten.
3. Adjust lamp arm (B) to desired angle. Secure by turning the adjustable handlebar (F) clockwise.  
Caution: Place the large metal column (E) between the small metal column (C) and the medium metal column (D).
4. Insert the bulb (A) into the socket. Turn clockwise until secure.
5. Plug into proper electrical outlet and test the lamp.
6. Assembly is complete.

### CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Do not use polishes or cleaners on the lamp.  
Wipe clean with a soft, dry cloth.
