## FURNITURE TIPPING RESTRAINT INSTRUCTIONS

### ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Determine the final position of the furniture piece.
2. Attach two of the mounting brackets with rings (preferably approx 6" from each side) near the top back edge of the furniture piece by inserting shorter screws. See Figure 1 below.
3. Determine the final position of the furniture piece. Drill starter holes into the wall stud at the level of the brackets on the furniture piece. Always attach to stud wherever possible. Fix the bracket with ring to the wall stud using 1 1/2" screws. See Figure 2 below.
4. Move the furniture piece in line with the brackets installed on the wall.
5. Lace one end of the nylon restraint strap through each ring. Bring both ends together and slide the beaded end until it snap locks into the keyhole slot. See Figure 3 & 4 below.
6. Check to make sure that the straps are securely laced and locked to the brackets.
