ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Please make sure that you have all parts and hardware indicated above before you start assemble this item
- 2. This item should be assembled on a soft surface to prevent scratching of the finish during assembly.
- 3. This item may require periodic tightening.

TO ASSEMBLE:

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic covering.
- 2. Place the lamp base (F) on the tabletop carefully.
- 3. Insert Harp (B) into the Saddle (E).
- 4. Insert the CFL bulb (C) , into threaded socket (D).
- 5. Place the Shade (Sold Separately) on Finail Plate. Attach the finial (A) and tighten to secure the shade.
- 6. Plug into proper electrical outlet and test fixture.
- 7. Assembly is complete.

- * Use only top and bottom open shade for 40 Wt. lamps.
