
TOOLS AND INSTALLATION

Tools Necessary: Allen Key (included).

NOTE: It may be easier to assemble product with two people.

NOTE: When inserting bolts, turn clockwise until tight. Then loosen 1/2-3/4 of a turn. After crib is completely assembled, return to each bolt and tighten.

WARNING: ENTRAPMENT/ STRANGULATION HAZARD

Infants have died in toddler beds from entrapment and strangulation. Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.

NEVER use bed with children under 15 months.


NEVER place bed near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.

- The mattress intended for use on the bed shall be a full-size crib mattress having minimum dimensions of 51 5/8 inches (1310 mm) in length, 27 1/4 inches (690 mm) in width and 4 inches (100 mm) in thickness, not exceeding 6 inches (152 mm) in thickness.
- If guardrails are used as the mattress containment means, guardrail(s) provided must be used to avoid the formation of a gap between the mattress and the bed that could cause an entrapment.
- DO NOT place bed near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- DO NOT place items with a string, cord, or ribbon around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords.
- A child using the toddler or day bed shall be at least 15 months of age and shall not weigh more than 50 lbs (22.7 kg).



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1:



Remove Stationary Side Rail (B) from the crib by carefully unscrewing and removing the (4pcs) Long bolts with spring washer on Left /Right sides of the Stationary Side Rail (B) using Allen Key (9).



STEP 2:

If mattress support is not in the lowest position, loosen all tightened bolts from side frames. Spread front of crib open enough to remove mattress support (C), and move it to the lowest position.


Note: The Mattress support (C) must be at the lowest level for a toddler bed.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


STEP 3:

Position the Toddler Rail (D) between the Headboard/ Footboard (A) and align the holes.



STEP 4:


Attach the Toddler Rail (D) to the crib by securing with Long Bolts (6), Spring Washers (8), and tighten with Allen Key (9).



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 5:

When converting the crib to toddler bed, the Small Bolt (7), and Spring Washer (8) should be inserted in the upper holes of the Side Frame (A) and tighten with the Allen Key (9).



WARNING:

After crib is completely assembled, return to each bolt and tighten to snug fit. DO NOT over tighten.
