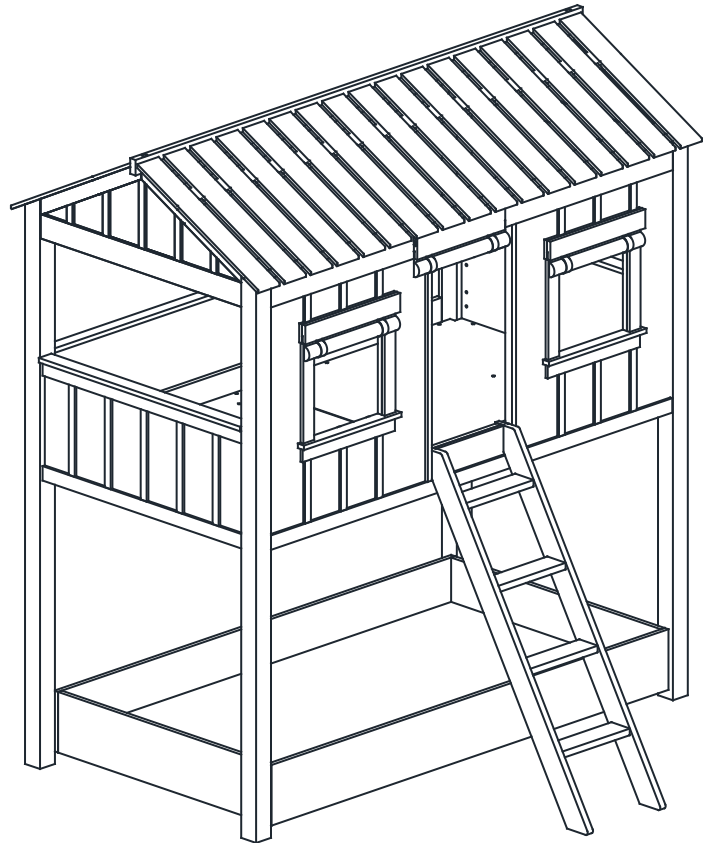

CARE AND CLEANING

DO NOT use abrasive chemicals for cleaning. Dust often using a clean, soft dry cloth. Rinse and dry thoroughly. If the Bunk bed is to be stored, store in a cool dry place and carefully package all original hardware to protect from loss.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION FOR BUNK BED:

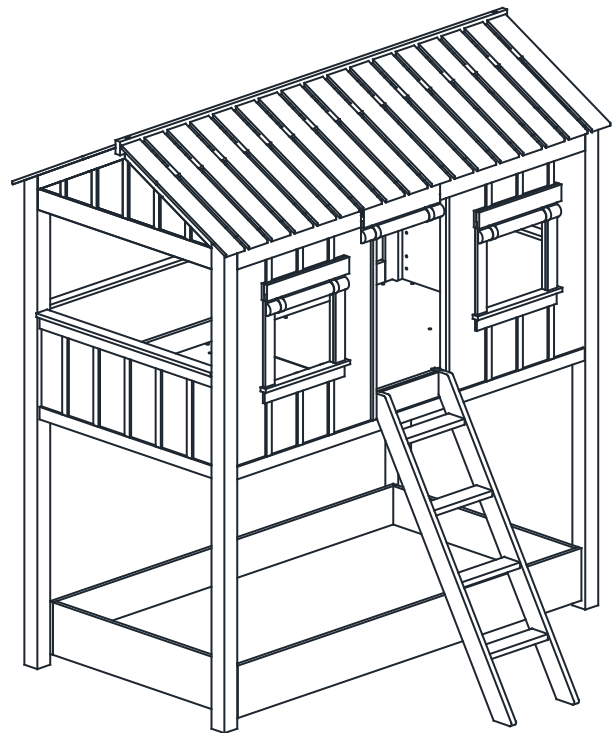
1. Follow the information on the WARNINGS appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton. DO NOT REMOVE WARNING LABEL FROM BED.
2. Always use the specified size mattress or mattress support, or both to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
3. Surface of mattress must be at least 5 inches below the upper edge of side rails on top bunk.
4. Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
5. Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
6. Periodically check and ensure that the side rails, ladder, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
7. Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
8. Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
9. Do not use substitute parts. Contact Restoration Hardware for replacement parts
10. Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
11. The use of water flotation mattresses is prohibited.
12. **STRANGULATION HAZARD** - Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed: for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jump ropes.
13. Keep these instructions for future reference.

**WARNING****TO HELP PREVENT SERIOUS OR FATAL INJURIES FROM ENTRAPMENT OR FALLS**

1. Never allow a child under 6 years on upper bunk.
2. Use only mattress, which is 74"-75" long and 37 1/2"-38 1/2" wide (TWIN BUNK) or 74"-75" long and 53 1/2"-54 1/2" wide (FULL BUNK) on upper bunk.
3. Ensure thickness of mattress does not exceed 9" and mattress surface is at least inches below upper edge of guardrails.
4. Use guardrails on both sides of upper bunk.
5. Prohibit horseplay on or under bed(s).
6. Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
7. Use ladder for entering and leaving upper bunk.
8. If the bunk bed will be placed next to a wall the guardrails that run the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.

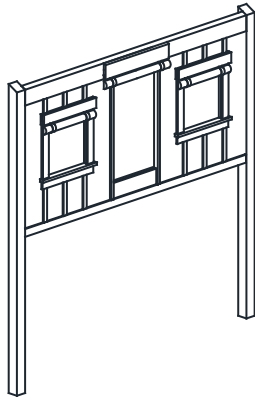
9. Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed, for example, but not limited to hooks, belts, and jump ropes.

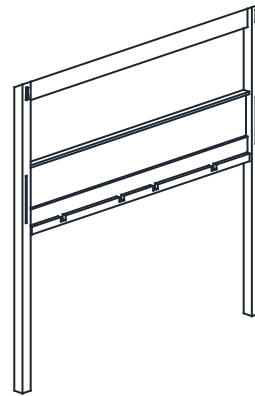

Please note, Headboard and Footboard are interchangeable and can be installed on either end of bunk.

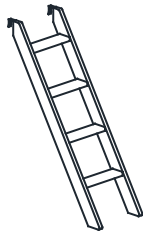
(A) Bed Front (x1 piece)



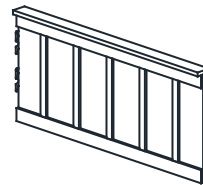
(B) Bed Back (x1 piece)



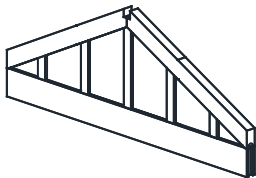
(C) Ladder (x1 piece)



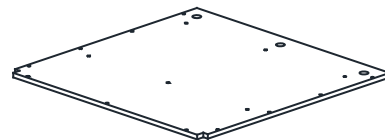
(D) Bottom Side Rails (x2 pieces)



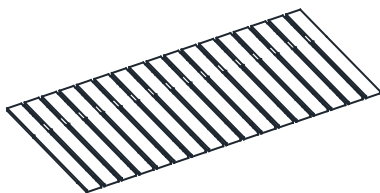
(E) Top Side Rails (x2 pieces)



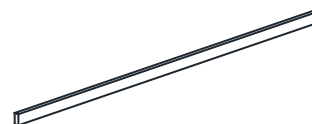
(F) Platform Panels (x2 pieces)

(I) Short Stretcher Bar (x4 pieces)



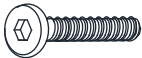

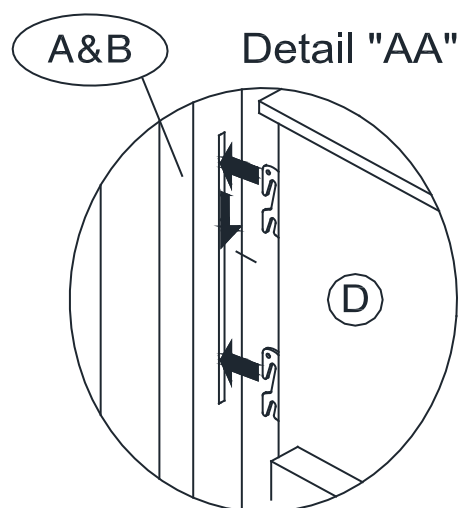
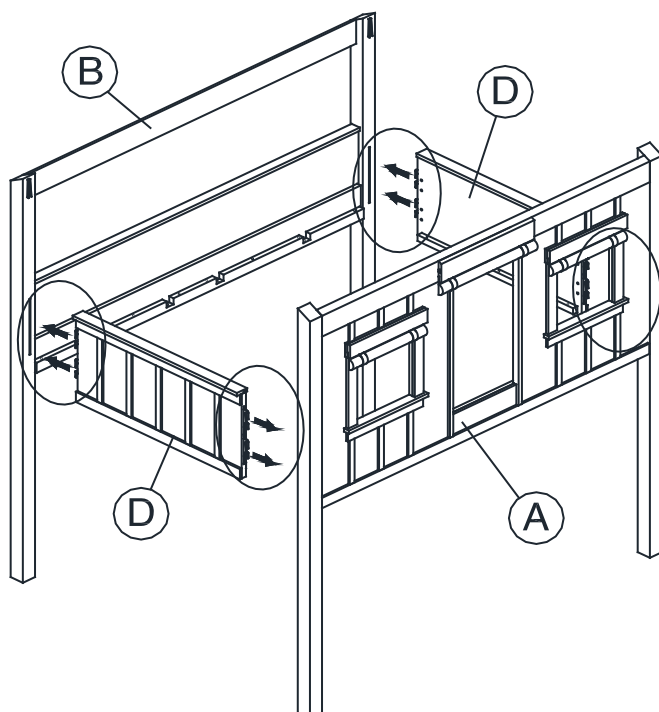
- Bed must be assembled by at least two people.
- Please read instructions carefully before assembling bed.
- Use the above parts and fittings list to identify each component.
- Keep all packing materials until assembly is complete to avoid loss of smaller parts.
- Do not completely tighten all bolts until all steps are finished.

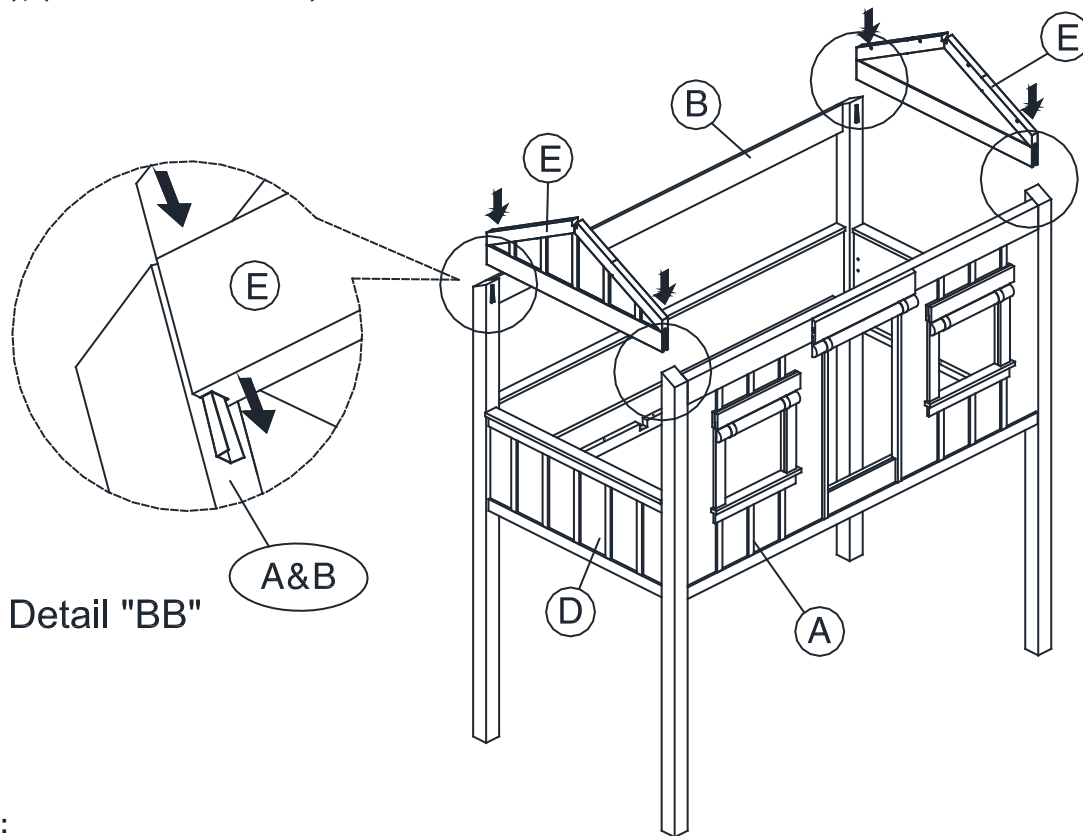
STEP 1:

While holding the Bed Front (A) & Bed Back (B) upright, place the hooks of the Bottom Side Rails (D) into the slots in the post of the Bed Front (A). If necessary, using a thick magazine or book to protect the Bottom Side Rails (D), hammer with a mallet or hammer until tight. Then hook the Bottom Side Rails (D) into the Bed Back (B), (refer to Detail "AA").

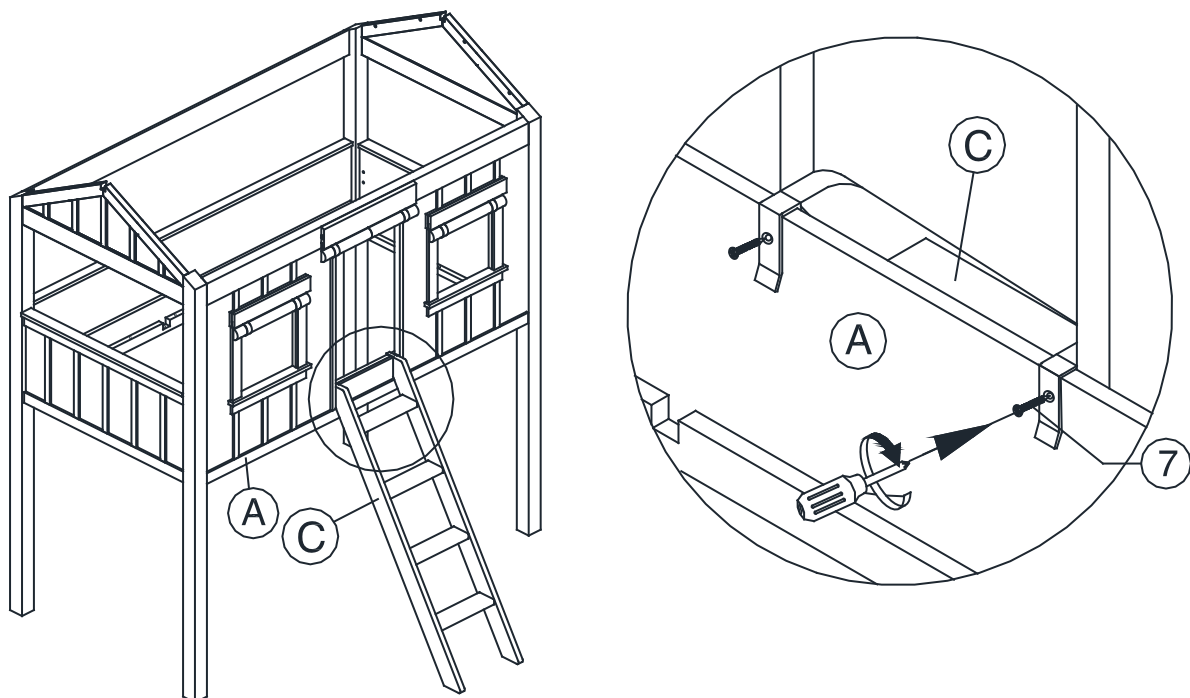


STEP 2:

Install the Top Side Rails (E) securely into the metal brackets on the Posts of Bed Front (A) & Bed Back (B), (refer to Detail "BB").

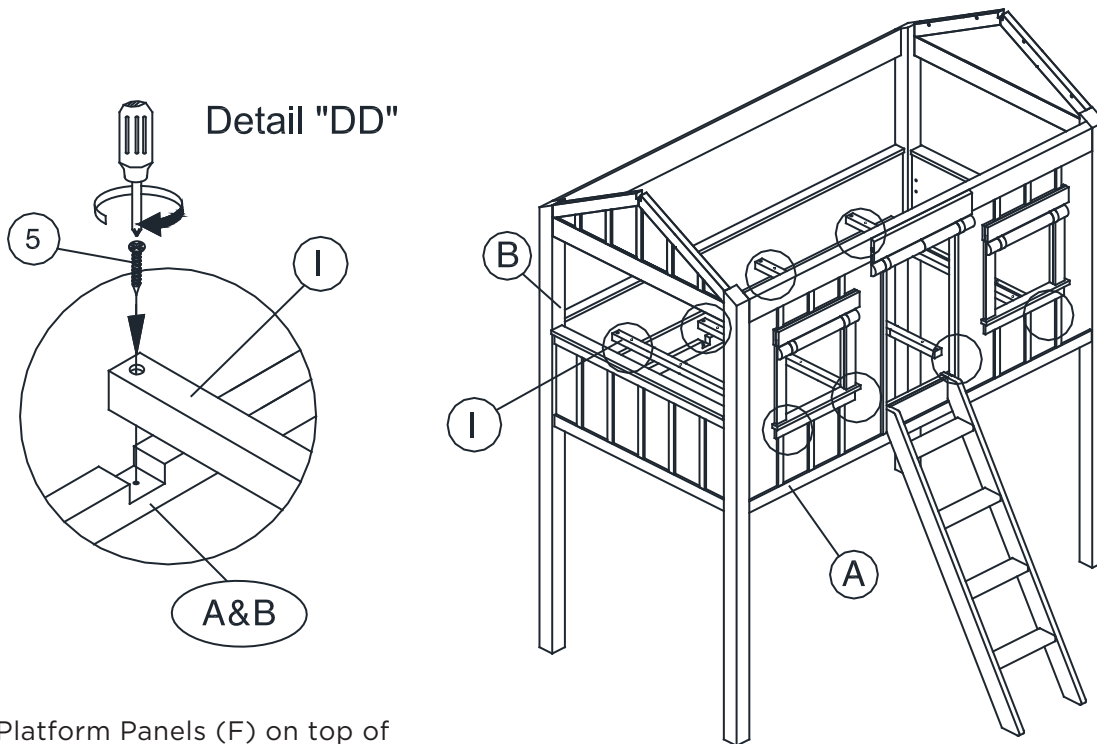
**STEP 3:**

Position the Ladder (C) in the opening in the Bed Front (A). Hook the Ladder (C) over the rails of Bed Front (A) and tighten with Short Screws (7) using Phillips head screwdriver (refer to Detail "CC").

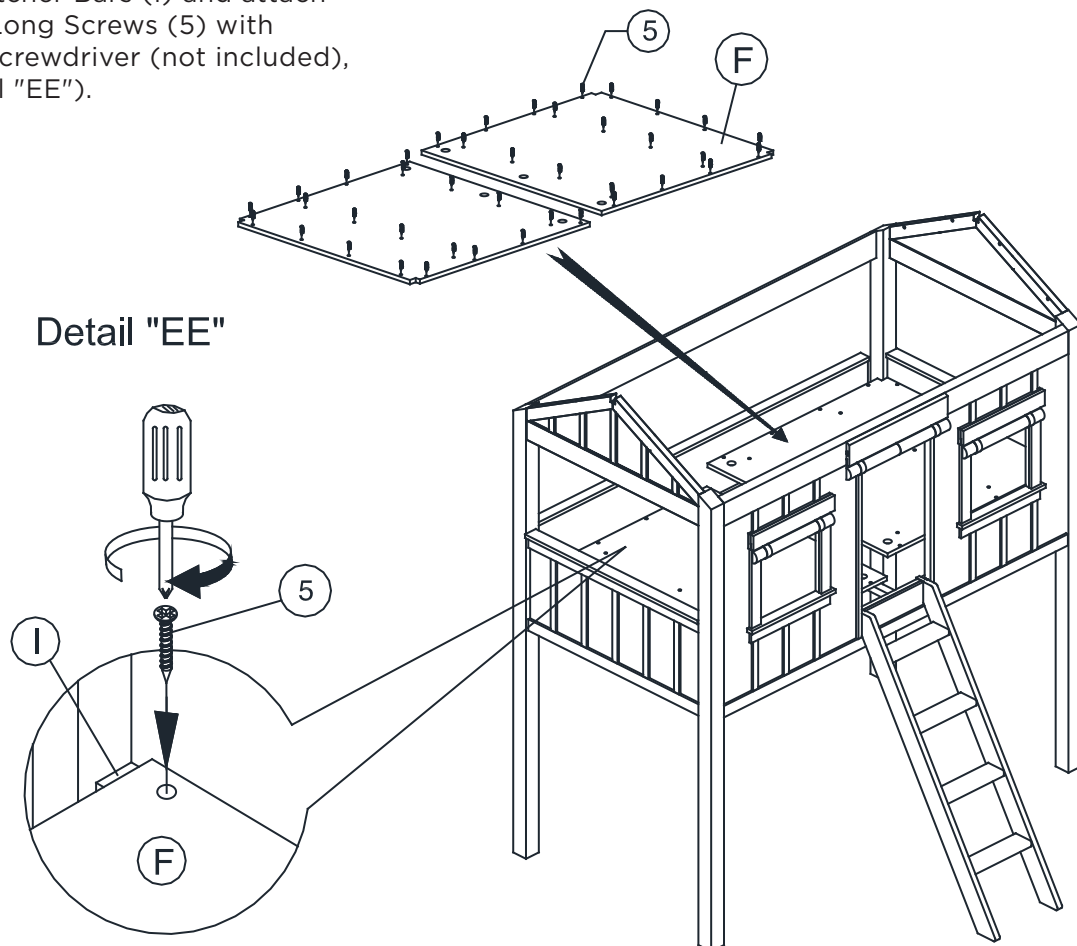

STEP 4:

Lay the 4 Short Stretcher Bars (I) in between the Bed Front (A) and Bed Back (B), then tighten using Long Screws (5) and Phillips head screwdriver (refer to Detail "DD").

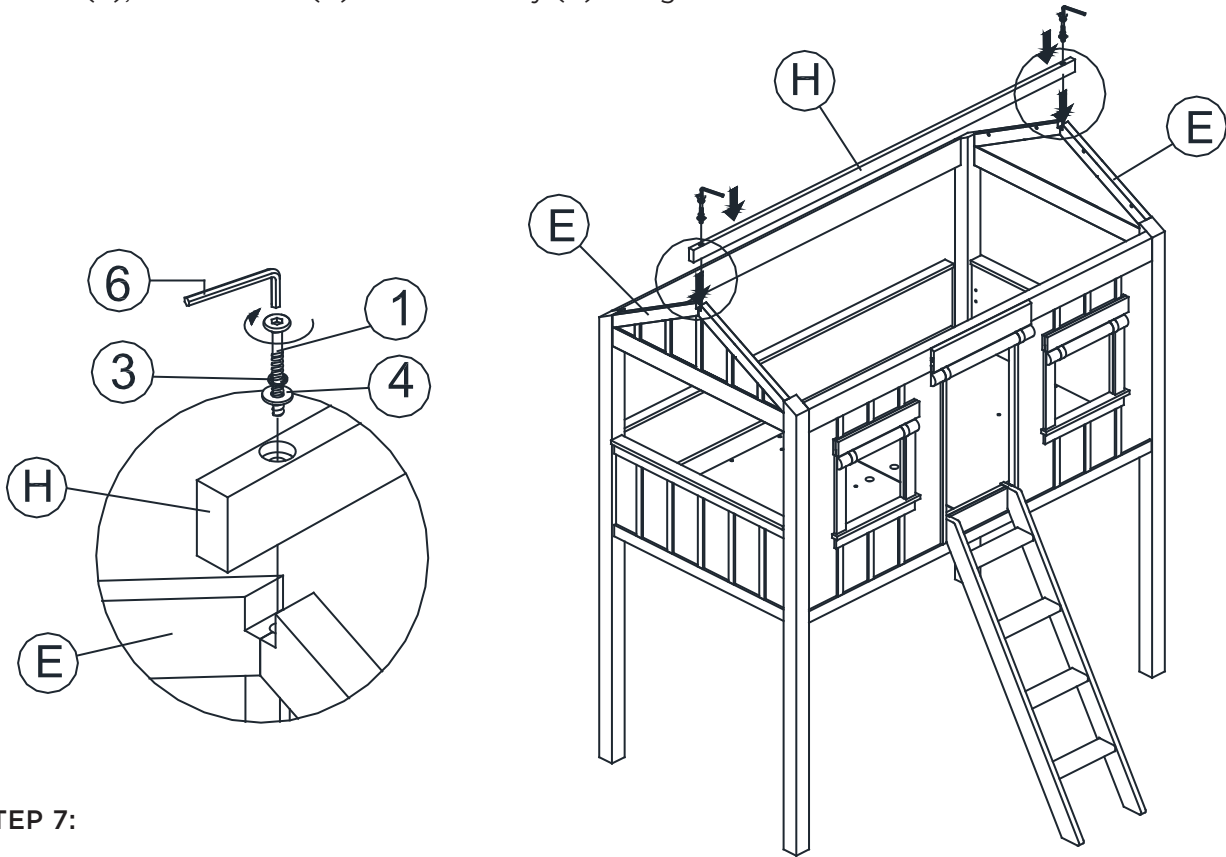
**STEP 5:**

Lay the Platform Panels (F) on top of the Short Stretcher Bars (I) and attach using Qty.40 Long Screws (5) with Phillips head screwdriver (not included), (refer to Detail "EE").



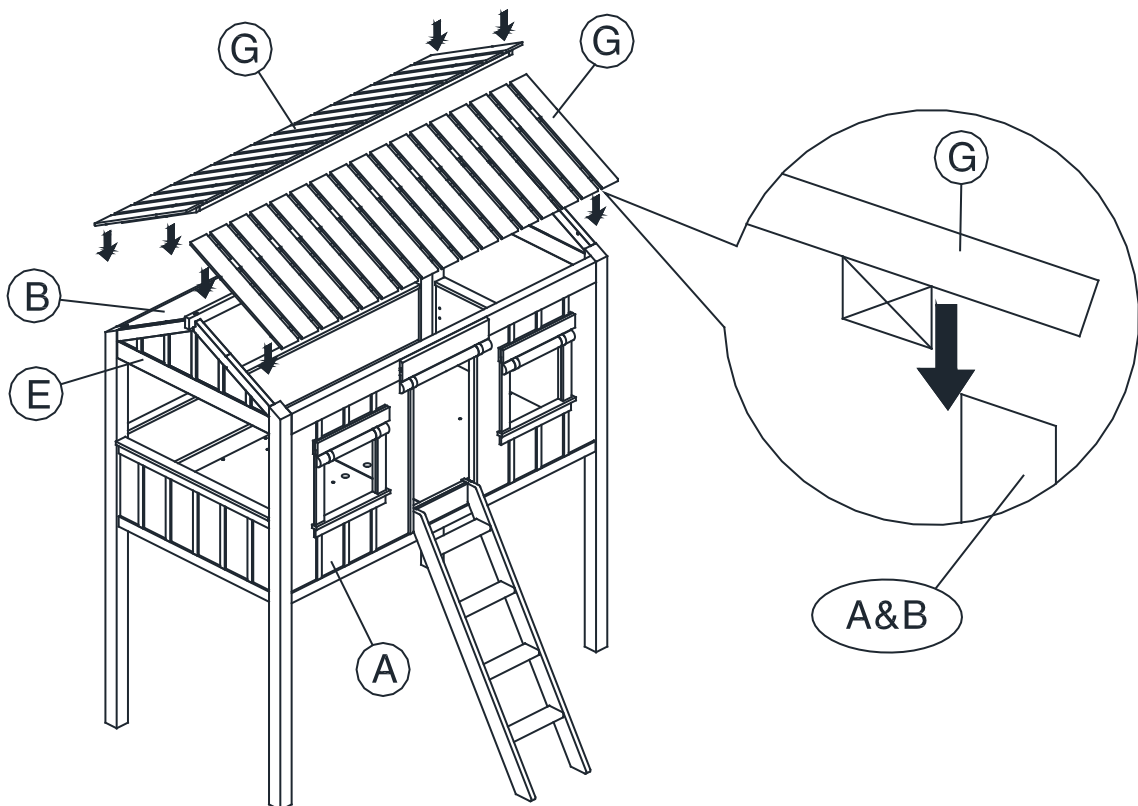
STEP 6:

Attach the Long Stretcher Bar (H) onto the top of Top Side Rails (E) by using Long Bolt (1), Spring Washer (3), Flat Washer (4) and Allen Key (6) to tighten.



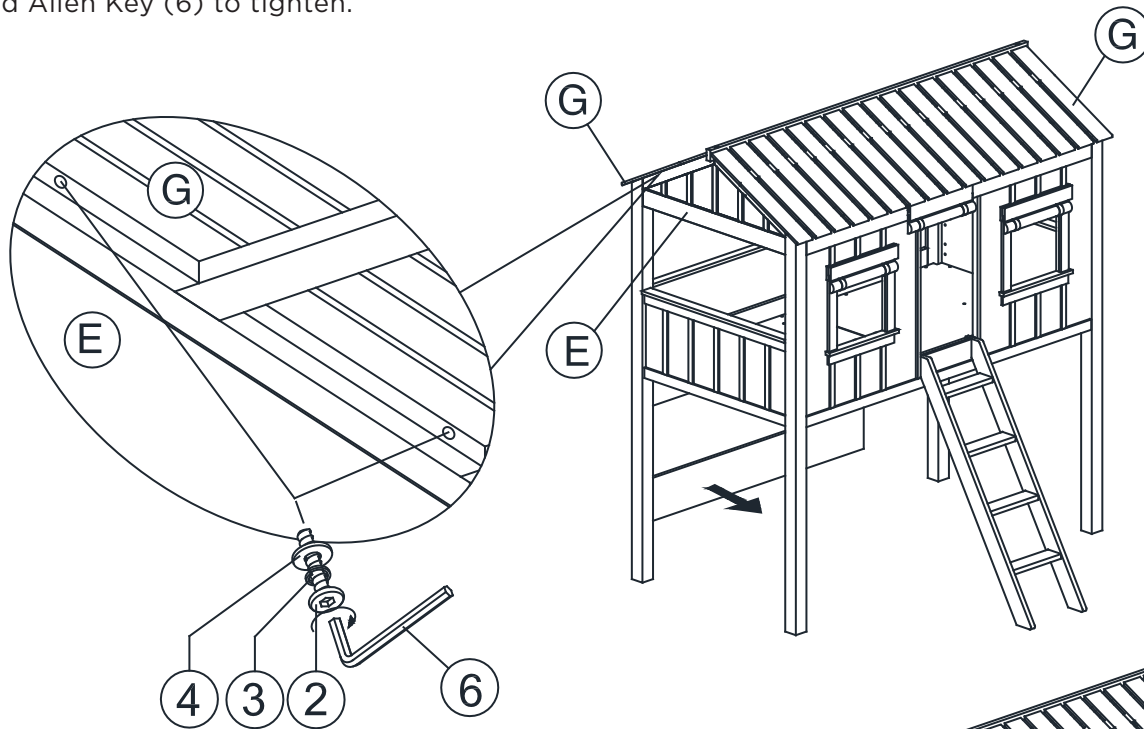
STEP 7:

Set the Roof (G) on top of assembled bed frame.

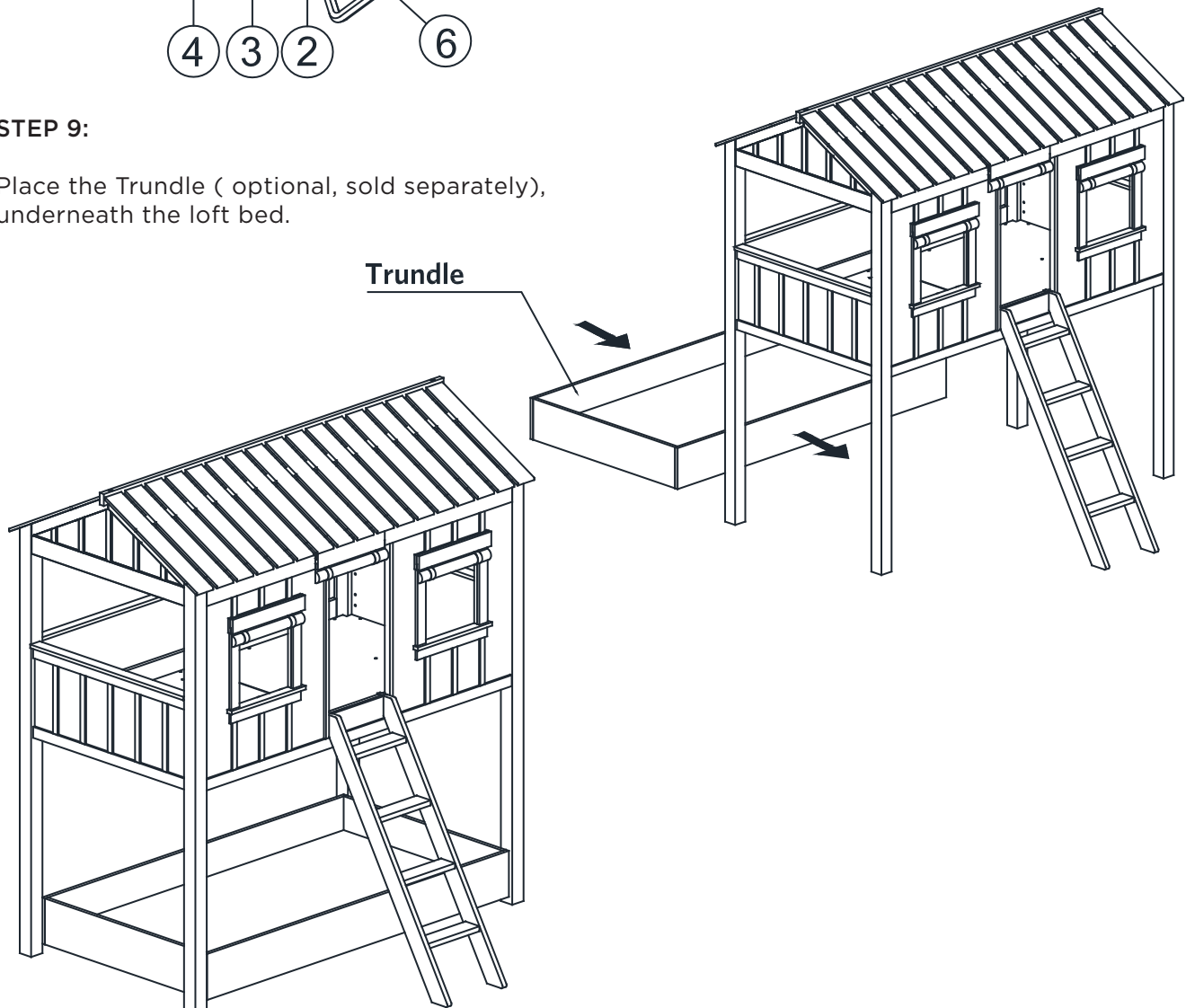


STEP 8:

Attach Roof (G) to the Top Side Rail (E) by using Short Bolt (2), Spring Washer (3), Flat Washer (4) and Allen Key (6) to tighten.

**STEP 9:**

Place the Trundle (optional, sold separately), underneath the loft bed.



STEP 10: INSTALL BEDDING**BEDDING SPECIFICATIONS FOR TOP BUNK:**

The following size mattress and Foundation are specified for use with this Bunk bed.

MATTRESS DIMENSION SPECIFICATIONS FOR TOP BUNK:

Twin - over - twin Bunk: (74" - 75") long x (37 1/2" - 38 1/2") wide x 9" thick.

Full - over - full bunk: (74" - 75") long x (53 1/2" - 54 1/2") wide x 9" thick.

PLATFORM:

-Twin - over - twin bunk: Upper bed consists of 2 pcs platform 37 3/4" long x 38 3/4" wide x 3/4" thick.

-Full - over - full Bunk: Upper bed consists of 2 pcs platform 37 3/4" long x 53 7/8" wide x 3/4" thick.

****Note: MATTRESS THICKNESS MUST NOT EXCEED MAX 9" FOR TOP BUNK.**

Be sure to adhere to these BEDDING SPECIFICATIONS in order to avoid the possibility of falling or entrapment. THESE SPECIFICATIONS MUST BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO !
